

Glen Eden wastewater storage and pipeline upgrades



Concrete storage tank 12 metres into the ground.

Watercare and our contractor, McConnell Dowell, have been upgrading the wastewater network in your area since August last year.

Harold Moody Reserve and Glendale Road

Pipe drilling and laying continues between shafts along Glendale Road. The last two shafts, between the storage tank in Harold Moody Reserve and Levy Road will be excavated next. Before this work can start, traffic management in the area needs to be adapted to ensure everyone's safety.

The detour that currently runs down Levy Road will move north to Woodvale Road. Glendale Road will be one-way (southbound) between Woodvale Road and Glengarry Road. The detour will continue around Ambler Avenue to Glengarry Road but the temporary traffic lights may be removed as early as April.

At Harold Moody Reserve, the walls of the holding tank have been constructed and the earth inside the tank removed, lowering it to the maximum depth. We will now begin construction of the floor, the roof and the network pipe connections.

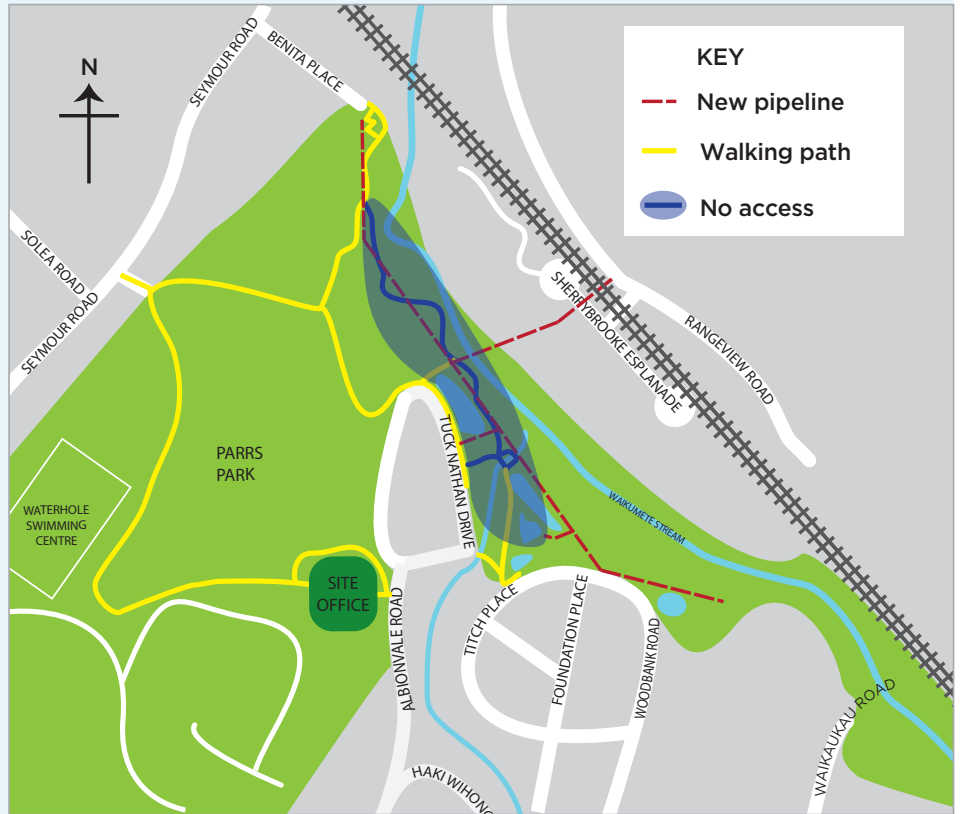
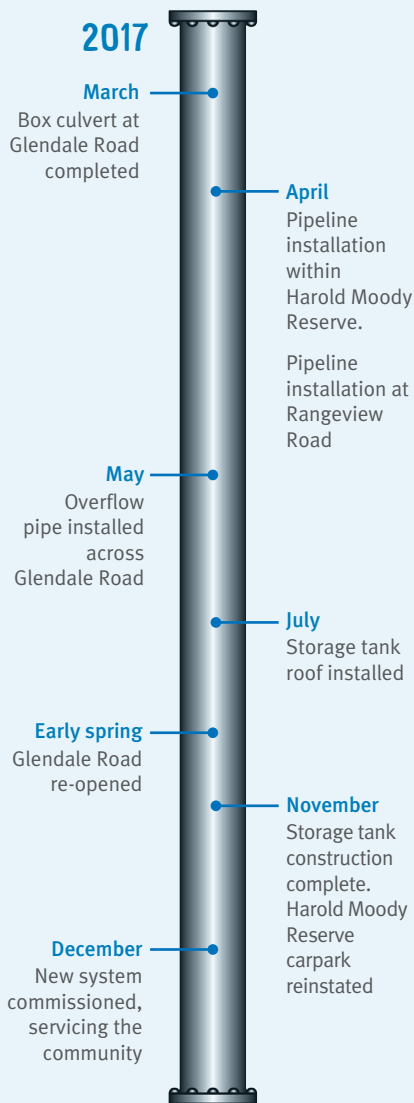
The pipeline running alongside the sports fields to the tank at Harold Moody Reserve will be renewed in late March. We are talking to local sports clubs to minimise any inconvenience while this upgrade takes place.



Sunnyvale and Parrs Park

Work is also underway to upgrade the local network in Sunnyvale and Parrs Park. While we are upgrading these works, access to pedestrian footpaths around the park may be closed for public safety. Signage will be displayed around the area to indicate where this work is taking place and which areas are inaccessible.
