Notices of Requirement for the North Harbour 2 Watermain (NH2) and the Northern Interceptor Shared Corridor (NI) Project and Application for resource consent for the NH2.

Please find enclosed Notices of Requirement for NH2 and NI and application for resource consents for the NH2.

Watercare Services Limited request that the NoR and resource consent applications are publicly notified in accordance with Section 95A(2)(b) of the Resource Management Act.

The Notices of Requirement to designate are for three separate land areas that will provide for the NH2 and NI alignments. The purposes of the designations are for the construction, on-going operation and maintenance of the NH2 and NI infrastructure. Watercare seeks to designate the full length of NH2, but only a portion of NI.

The three designation corridors proposed are:

NOR1 - for the NH2 from Titirangi to the eastern end of Fred Taylor Drive;

NOR2 - for the NH2 from the eastern side of Greenhithe Bridge to the Albany Reservoir; and

NOR3 - that will be a shared corridor for the NH2 and a section of NI from the eastern end of Fred Taylor Drive to the western end of the Greenhithe Bridge Causeway.

The Notices and consent application have been prepared in accordance with Section 88 and 168 of the Resource Management Act 1991 (RMA) and describe the proposal, assesses the environmental effects and evaluates it against the provisions of the Operative Auckland Council District Plan, Proposed Auckland Unitary Plan and the Operative Auckland Council Regional Plan: Air, Land and Water.

2. Proposed Designation Conditions
3. North Harbour 2 and Northern Interceptor Shared Corridor :
