Northcote wastewater pipeline upgrades

In October, we will begin a project to replace an existing wastewater pipeline with a larger one between Akoranga Drive and Lake Road, Northcote. At an investment of \$9 million, this project will increase network capacity and support growth in Northcote. The existing pipe will be made redundant once the new pipe has been built.

Works will start from Cadness Street moving north towards Akoranga Drive, and south towards Lake Road. Built mainly through private land, the pipeline will also cross Tonar Street and the Northcote shopping centre car park.

During these sections of work, road layout changes and parking restrictions will temporarily be in place. To minimise disruption we will have two crews working simultaneously, reducing the construction time.

How will the project affect you?

- The North Harbour Table Tennis Stadium, YMCA and Northcote shops will remain open during the upgrades
- Construction areas will be fenced for the safety of the public
- Working hours will be from 7am to 7pm, Monday to Friday; and Saturday 7am to 2pm.


The new pipe will be 900 metres long and 1 metre in diameter
