

# Northern Interceptor Wastewater Pipeline project

As Auckland continues to grow, we need to ensure that our infrastructure can cope with the increasing amount of wastewater that is generated.

At the moment, wastewater from Massey North, Whenuapai, Hobsonville, Kumeu, Huapai and Riverhead is sent down to the Mangere Wastewater Treatment Plant to be treated. To manage the increasing volumes as this area continues to develop, we are building a new pipeline (the Northern Interceptor) to divert this wastewater to the nearby Rosedale Wastewater Treatment Plant and free up some capacity at Mangere.

## Where will the new wastewater pipe be located?

The Northern Interceptor will eventually run from the Concourse Wastewater Storage Tank in Henderson, up to the Rosedale Wastewater Treatment Plant in Albany, as shown on the accompanying map.

## What approvals have already been obtained?

Statutory approvals have already been obtained for the first phase of the project, to install a smaller wastewater pipe. Starting in 2017, construction of this phase of the Northern Interceptor will accommodate immediate growth in the northwest for the next 15 to 20 years. Over time, we will need to install a bigger pipe and pump stations to get the wastewater from the Concourse in Henderson to Rosedale.

## What are the current approvals required for?

In order to protect the route of future Northern Interceptor stages from ongoing development, Watercare is seeking to designate the alignment.

## Will this work affect my property?

In most cases pipe laying will take place primarily in the road corridor. However, there will be public areas where future infrastructure is proposed.

If we need to do any work in your property we will have already sent you a letter to let you know.

## What happens next?

We are currently updating people who live in the area about the project and talking to affected property owners. Our next step will be to give our Notice of Requirement for a designation to secure the route. We expect to lodge this mid-year.
